

2020 MICRO MAGIC CLASS NATIONAL CHAMPIONSHIP REGATTA NOTICE OF RACE

(Friday), Saturday, Sunday, May (15), 16, 17, 2020 Hosted by The Azura MYC, Paonia, Colorado - AMYA # 331

The Azura MYC is located on the grounds of a wonderful local winery and art gallery, and our pond has a view that likely equals that of any sailing venue anywhere. Ty and Helen Gillespie, the winery owners, are warm, delightful people, and Helen is a fabulous cook. We have very good weather and reliable wind. Our little town is idyllic, with many local wineries, two local minimicrobreweries, and good local restaurants. Lastly, we are a very friendly group and very much look forward to hosting you.

Eligibility: Any duly registered owner of a Micro Magic Class boat, <u>who is a</u> <u>member of the AMYA</u>, or his/her appropriate national authority, may participate in this regatta.

Entry: An eligible owner/skipper may enter the regatta by completing and returning the attached Entry Form, together with an appropriate check, to the address indicated. Mail in entries must be sent in by <u>April 30, 2020</u>, but late entries will be accepted if space is available.

Because the pond at Azura MYC is small, total entries will be limited to 24.

Regatta Site: The regatta will be sailed on Azura Pond, Azura Winery and Gallery, 16764 Farmers Mine Road, Paonia, Colorado, 81428.

Schedule of Events:

Please note: Our little pond has reliable, though very shifty mountain winds, implying that on sunny days we have good wind from the east from very early in the morning until about 10 am, then wind from the west from about 1 pm until sundown. For that reason, we will start racing very early on both Saturday and Sunday.

(Friday, May 15): Registration, Inspection, and practice 12:00 – 5:00 pm. Practice races from 1:00pm – 5:00pm. Immediately following, anyone interested can go with us up tho the Azura Winery or to the fabulous Paonia United Brewery (formerly Revolution Brewing) in tiny downtown Paonia. Please note that the practice is optional, but the brewery is a must see.

Saturday, May 16: Registration, inspection, and practice 7:00 am. Skipper's Meeting 7:30 am. Morning racing starts at 8:00 am through 10 am. Lunch 12:00 – 12:45 pm. Afternoon racing starts at 1:00 pm. Last race will start before 5:00 pm or earlier at the RD's discretion. Wine and beer at the MYC immediately following the racing, and dinner at the winery starting at 6:30 pm.

Sunday, May 17: Skipper's Meeting at 7:45 am. Morning racing starts at 8:00 am to 10am. Lunch 12:00 – 12:45pm. Afternoon racing starts at 1:00pm. Last race will begin before 3:00 pm or earlier at the RD's discretion. Beer, wine, and awards immediately following.

Rules: The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in the current 2017-2020 Racing Rules of Sailing, as modified by Appendix E, the Sailing Instructions, and the International Micro Magic Class Rules.

Racing Format: The race committee will determine the number of races for each day after considering the weather, course, and equipment conditions. Three races are to be completed to constitute a regatta. If there are more than 10 entries, racing may be conducted under the Heat Management System (HMS).

Awards: AMYA Gold Chevrons will be awarded for the top three places. Event Trophies will be awarded to the top 5 skippers.

Frequency Assignment: Since most competitors use 2.4 GHz transmitter/receivers this should not be an issue. Participants using non-2.4 GHz equipment should list all of their available radio frequencies on the regatta entry

form. Frequency assignments will be handled on a first come, first served basis. Every effort will be made to assign one of the frequencies listed on the entry form. We will contact the involved skippers to resolve the conflicts.

Inspection: All boats will be inspected for conformance with International Micro Magic Class Rules at the time of registration. Measurement will include verification of minimum weight, sail size, keel fin and bulb weight, and other aspects as determined by the Class Secretary. All boats must display sail numbers on the main. Jib numbers are desirable, but not mandatory.
